Dr. Steve Hull has submitted his resignation as superintendent of Falcon School District, the District announced today.

“Regrettably, it became increasingly apparent that there were irreconcilable differences between the Board and Dr. Hull, and it became apparent that it was in everyone’s best interest for the District and Dr. Hull to go in separate directions,” said Board President Dave Martin. “We simply desire to move forward with all district stakeholders with the common goal of student achievement. To this end we need to move forward now to retain and fill several important positions and we were unable to do so until this matter was resolved. We wish Dr. Hull the best in whatever endeavor he chooses to take and thank him for his service to the District.”

“The Board and I were unable to resolve our differences. I believe it’s in the best interest of the District that I resign,” said Dr. Hull. “It has been a privilege working with the District and its employees, parents and children and I wish the best for the Falcon School District.”

Dr. Hull will remain on the District payroll through the end of this month but will be taking unused vacation through that time. The Board will begin a search for a successor immediately.
