

A PROVEN TRACK RECORD OF SUCCESS


The Literacy Excellence Program, also known as “LEx”, was launched at Odyssey Elementary School in 2014 to support students with characteristics of Dyslexia. ALLIES’ goal is to replicate these successful processes in a new school fully dedicated to the Take Flight intervention and accommodations in classrooms.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

My child has an Individualized Education Plan. Will he/she be a candidate?

Yes, if the IEP is in the area of speech or a specific learning disability for reading, writing or math, and a screening or diagnosis shows that he/she is a good candidate. Services will not be available for other special education programming. Reading services and times will be met through the Take Flight intervention program per parent consent.

Will there be busing?


For students living in District 49, buses will be available from Ridgeview Elementary School and Stetson Elementary School. All other students will be responsible for transportation to and from ALLIES.
