Meet or exceed the state average for students demonstrating proficiency on CMAS, PSAT, and SAT.


Meet or exceed the 50th median growth percentile in 4-8th Grade CMAS ELA and Math.

- Utilize STAR 360 results (grades 1-11), and Acadience Reading benchmarks (grades K-5), to drive instruction and interventions.
- Use Math 180 (6-10) and Read 180 (6-8) to support students performing below grade level.
- Use questioning to validate learners understanding of success criteria and learning intentions
- Support teachers in integrating teacher-to-student, and student-to-student feedback




Increase percentage of K-3 students reading at or above benchmark from 74% to 85%

- Use CKLA with fidelity across all K-5 classrooms.
- Progress monitor students well-below/below benchmark with 95% fidelity.
- Implement and sustain research affirmed literacy interventions across all K-5 classrooms.



Increase the 4-year graduation rate from 87% to 90%


- Implement and sustain exemplary student advisement practices at Sand Creek High School and Horizon Middle School.
- Provide learners with multiple avenues to demonstrate mastery in all subject areas, to include capstone courses and projects, as well as workplace learning opportunities.



Increase Family Engagement Survey overall mean from 4.15 to 4.20.


Increase Student Engagement Survey overall mean from 3.80 to 3.90.

- Zone Leader will round with each schools' families and students at least two times per year
- Hold four zone-wide community events.
- Highlight and share best practices schools are using to increase parent/family satisfaction



Increase Employee Engagement Survey overall mean from 4.27 to 4.32.

- Leaders will round with each staff member at least 2 times per year.
- Leaders will conduct 45 day meetings with all new staff members.
- Reward and recognize staff for exhibiting criteria aligned with the Zone Standards of Excellence and Pillars.
- Provide individualized professional development two times per year



Implement distinctive programming and experiences that meet the needs of learners

- Assemble groups of stakeholders to assist in planning new and high demand pathways (Law, Criminal Justice and Public Safety)
- Increase pathways available to learners at Sand Creek High School based on interest and job demand



Implement wrap around services in an effort to support learners, staff, parents and community members

- Assemble stakeholders to create a plan to integrate school based wrap around services
- Open a zone community resource center using existing space to provide food and clothing to the zone community
