- Deadline is April 16, 2021

Jackie Robinson Foundation Scholarship

- The Jackie Robinson Foundation provides four-year scholarships of \$30,000 to highly motivated African American students who have maintained a 98% college graduation rate.

The Boettcher Foundation

- A merit-based scholarship for Colorado high school seniors provides what is essentially a full-ride to any four-year institution in Colorado.
- Students must be a graduating Colorado high school senior who has lived in Colorado for your junior and senior years of high school and be a citizen, legal permanent resident, or lawfully present in the United States.
- Application must be submitted no later than November 1, 2020 by 5:00 pm.

Daniels Fund

- The Daniels Scholarship Program provides a four-year annually-renewable college scholarship for graduating high school seniors who demonstrate exceptional character, leadership, and a commitment to serving their communities.
- Eligible applicants must: be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States; be a resident of Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, or Wyoming and a high school senior.
- Earn a minimum SAT Math score of 490 and a minimum Evidence-Based Reading & Writing score of 490 or a minimum, ACT score of 18 in each category (writing score not required); have a 3.0 GPA; and, demonstrate financial need.
- Daniels Scholarships may not be used at technical or trade schools, or for participation in certificate programs.
- Application deadline is November 13, 2020.

2021 Design A Better Future Scholarship

WUE Award

- To be considered for the WUE Award, you must be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident and have a permanent residence within one of the following participating states/U.S. territories: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, Guam, and Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands (CNMI).
- WUE recipients receive a savings of approximately \$12,886 per year, for four years.
- Must have a 3.2 GPA from high school, and maintain a 2.5 for renewal.
- Deadlines vary depending on which semester you apply for. For more information or to apply, please visit the scholarship provider's website.

Sachs Foundation Undergraduate Scholarship

- The Sachs Foundation Undergraduate Scholarship is only for African American Colorado high school seniors who will be attending college in the fall (must have lived in Colorado for at least five years).
- Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA.
- Undergraduate scholarships range between \$8,000.00 - \$10,000.00 per year. This amount could vary depending upon fund availability.
- Applications must be submitted between January 1, 2021 and March 15, 2021
