Keeping Skills Sharp

Reading:

- Read 20 minutes a day
- Read aloud to someone
- Be read to by someone
- Read non-fiction (ex: newspaper or magazine)

Math:

- Practice and know basic addition and subtraction facts
- Practice subtraction with borrowing
- Tell time to the nearest $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, and hour
- Practice rounding numbers

Writing:

- Weekly Journal Entry
- Write a letter to a friend or relative
- Proofread your writing for capitals and punctuation
