Amount	\$132,273	
Rationale	In 2018-19, GOAL Academy Tech purchased 1000 Lenovo Windows 10 student computers at a total cost of \$253,370. This was done to continue to support our 1-to-1 initiative and increase online curriculum capabilities for our students. These new computers contain better hardware, which has allowed GOAL to begin looking at more dynamic curriculum and will support adapting and accelerating student learning in our online/blended environment. We are also using these machines to support our new Microsoft Certification offerings and build the groundwork for upcoming Tech CTE programs. The request for MLO funds will cover the purchase of 639 computers for a total of \$132,273.
