The camera would provide surveillance of our storage sheds, side parking, and dumpsters. There have been multiple instances where high school age students have been loitering and vandalizing OES property on the west side of our building. This would also increase security for our night time custodial staff that has to access the loading area and dumpster at night. Yellow security walkie talkies: OES was provided with 10 school walkie talkies to start the school year. Currently, we saw a need to provide ALLIES a walkie so we can communicate with each other in an emergency drill or real work situation. Through the course of the first semester, we have found a need to have at least 5 more walkie talkies to support our lunchroom/recess monitors, our SSN classrooms for students that have potential severe medical needs, and to communicate to some classrooms (music and PE) that do not have capability to hear an emergency announcement through the schools overhead PA system.
