iConnect Zone Evaluation Procedures

Each of the district's iConnect Zone operated schools use the Colorado State Model Evaluation for teachers, special service providers and principals. 50% of the educator evaluation is based on the Colorado Quality Standards while the other 50% is based on two collective measures and two individual measures. For collective measures, one is based on state assessment, the other is related to the school's overall School Performance Framework. For individual measures, each educator works with his/her evaluator to develop two goals based on student learning objectives. The measures are defined and written into the evaluation annually.

Here is the breakdown:

- 50% - Standards
- 12.5% - State Assessments
- 12.5% - SPF Rating
- 12.5% - Individual Measure
- 12.5% - Individual Measure
