



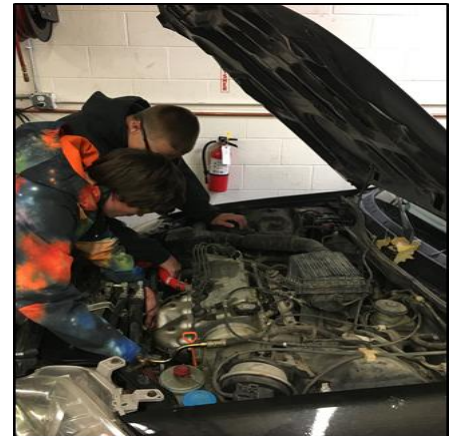
The Peyton Automotive Technology Program
