Discipline

Restorative Practices

Elaine Charney is the assistant principal over discipline. She will discuss Pack Panel and stats from it.

Restorative practices being pushed from district (Mr. Hilts)

Helping kids learn from their mistakes to minimize future referrals, suspensions, and/or expulsions.

Meeting kids where they are, understanding what they are going through, being more thoughtful in the consequence assigned.

Students get to choose whether or not to go before the Pack Panel.

Pack Panel is a panel of the student's peers with an adult in the room, but run by the peer (student) panel. Student presents case first to panel, then parents meet with the panel. Consequence aim is to repair damage done to the school community. So, consequence is a form of community service.

Parents are encouraged to participate.

Once consequence is complete, the referral is removed.

3 years ago 162 referrals

2 years ago 157 referrals

This year 67 referrals

Only high school in the district and the area with this type of program. Other schools outside of the district are requesting information about our program.

Teachers can be a part of the panel - impact statement either in person or via video to explain how the student's behavior which led to the referral affected the teacher, the classroom, etc.

Students volunteer/apply to be a part of the Pack Panel - must have two teacher

recommendations. If selected, they go through a training, as do any adults who are involved. They aren't just "winging it".

CDE Planning Process

Standard performance framework from CDE at the beginning of the year is the starting point.

Three areas:

Academic Achievement (approaching) - overall / Big picture

Academic Growth (Approaching) - more specific break out - ELD, FRL, etc.

and Postsecondary & workforce readiness (meets) - dropout/graduation rates

First two areas are based on standardized testing - when parent opt their student out of testing it counts against us.

Parents said they opt out because the amount of testing is ridiculous and their kids were getting stressed out over a test that didn't affect them.

Feel PSAT, SAT have a purpose, but CMAS has no value - what college will look at that?

Improvement strategy 1

- Expand relationships and articulate with post-secondary educational program
- Through CE, students have access and opportunities to programming through PCC - we have the highest number of students enrolled

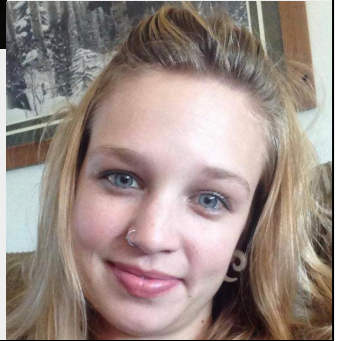
Additionally, on the 10th, 11th, and 12th - "we" will present at each of the middle schools in the district
