Those 2 Days Only The Students Being Assessed

Demonstration of Mastery Class 2021: English 470 - Math 500
(Assessments - College Credit - Certification - Capstones)

SAT will be Tuesday, April 9th for Juniors, with no school for Freshman and Sophomores. Freshmen and Sophomores will take the PSAT on Wednesday, April 10th with no school for Juniors. There is no school on both dates for Seniors.

Demonstration of Mastery must be demonstrated in Math and English starting with the Class 2021. This can be accomplished through assessment, college credit, certification or capstone. SAT and PSAT prep classes are still available for students that want help preparing for these assessments. A member requested that data be presented on the SAT/PSAT.

The SAT and PSAT are the priority, but the CMAS testing will take place at a later date. It will provide science data. It will be important that Parents opt out, so that it we don't have count against us. 85% participation is needed.

Principal Bruce Grose visited Math Lab at Rampart. Students receive one on one help during a pull out session from a class they are doing well in for tutoring in concepts additional help is needed . He is looking to provide a similar setup here for 9th and 10th graders, so they can fill in the gaps early on.
