**Call Meeting to Order**

Mr. Kyner opened the meeting stating the purpose of the meeting - the group serves as an advisory committee to give administration insight to the operations of the school.

Meetings are held during the year and often tied to our Zone Accountability Committee meetings in November, January and May.

- COVID / Opening updates

There are 4 areas of procedures to start in-person: distancing, hand hygiene, cohorting and masks. We are eating lunch in the rooms and outside and this has been running smoothly. Our online option is about 1/4 of the school; 147 students that amounts to about one teacher per grade level that is designated as the e-learning teacher.

Students will receive the same assessments in person and online. The delivery may be changed given the directions of the vendor.

Currently dismissal is through the front door; the grade level doors was suggested as a way to release quicker and it was noted that the congestion at the north end of the building and the cross walk would be impacted.

Relative to arrival, cars stop in the drop off lane until the doors open at 8:15. It is not possible to open the doors early due to staffing and scheduling of paras. It was suggested that drop off not early.

An instructional video to support proper parent drop off may be recorded and sent to parents.

- Enrollment and Budget Implications

We have 521 students currently - our projection was 541. District budgets are funded on the October count number. We've tightened the building budget and use COVID relief funds for some related expenses (masks, shields, professional development, staffing) to the outbreak.

- BOY Data

Teachers are using data to differentiate instruction to meet the needs of students with unfinished learning. Reading and math data will be resented in more detail at our next meeting.

- SRES Scorecard

The scorecard was presented to show the building's goals for the school year. The scorecard will be posted on the website for review.

- Military Student Transition Consultant, Martha Bodell presented about Military Child Education Coalition (MCEC), a parent organization. Can reach out to any community member or create community partnerships to help students succeed. Works with our Military and Family Life Counselors in specific buildings (MFLC).
