Introductions

Financial Priorities were reviewed. This is usually held at the beginning of the school year but had to be delayed due to COVID.

A survey was sent out to collect information on financial priorities for our communities.

Paula reviewed curricular deficits in regards to literacy. New curriculum was purchased through Collaborative Classroom (Being a Reader, Being a Writer, Making Meaning).

Community financial survey indicated the community wanted funds spent on curriculum or resources.

Plans for data, interventions, teacher training and coaching were shared and impact on students.

Title 1 funding was explained. Some of this money was set aside for family events.

Woodmen Valley Chapel has supported our families through food, gas cards and family meal baskets and Christmas gifts.

Financial survey results were shared as well as priorities for our school (as indicated by the survey).

Discussion was opened up to identify the priorities important to those attending the meeting.

The committee decided that Safety and Security could be dropped from the priority list based on the improvements made in the last few years.

- 2) Social Emotional Support
- 3) After School Clubs, Activities, Tutoring
- 4) Technology Replenishment
