 - Peter's Model Chart
 - This model reduces overall cost to the district by \$200,000
 - We are spending more of our District Adjusted Gross Revenue (DAGR) on non-administrative pay
 - Admin growth has been slower than our student growth
 - Most district leaders have 6-8 people that they oversee; our model is more effective than other districts' traditional model
 - BOE will determine the structure and then they will determine who should be in those positions (with a process)
