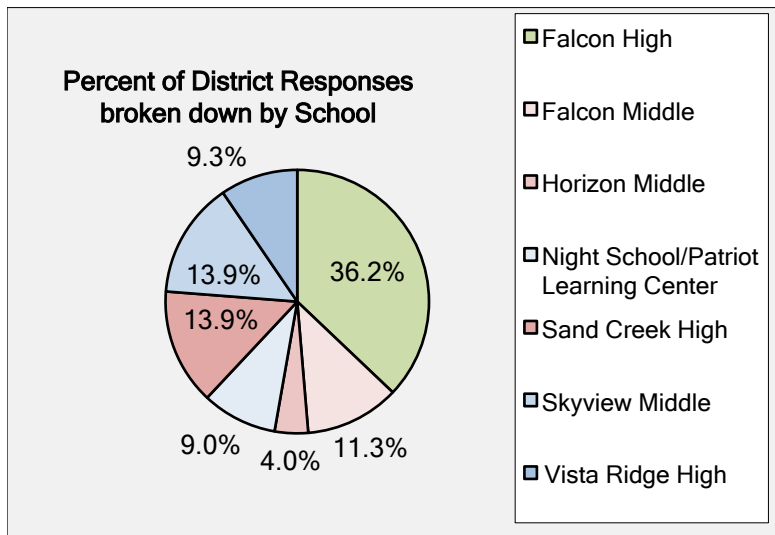


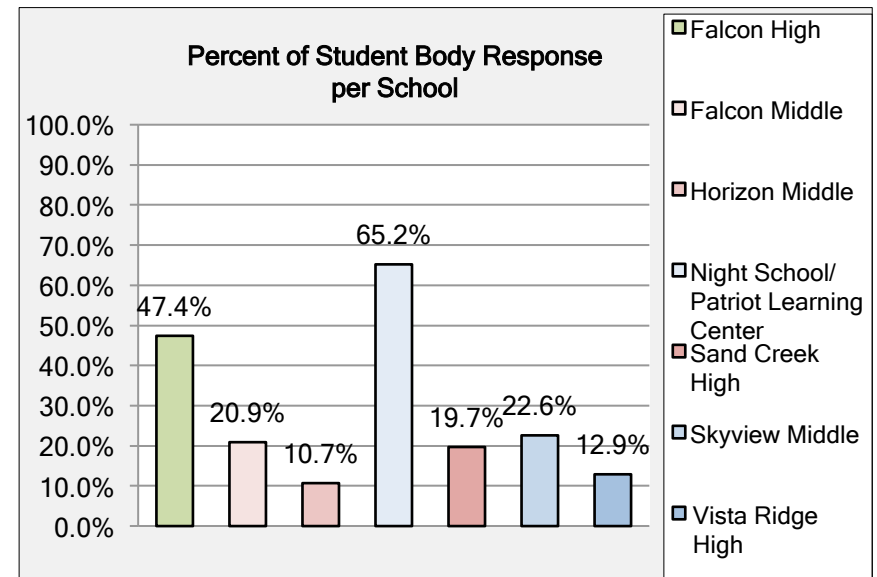

The first district survey occurred from Sept. 24 to Oct. 5, creating initial metrics for identifying future trends. Nearly 1,689 middle and high school students participated, or 26 percent of the district's sixth through 12th graders. The highest response rate occurred in Patriot Learning Center (65.2 percent) and Falcon High School (47.4), while the lowest were in Vista Ridge High School (12.9) and Horizon Middle School (10.7). The survey was administered online, allowing students to participate using school or home computers.



Although 26% of the secondary students in the district responded to the survey, Falcon High School students make up over a third of the total responses. Therefore, the district data is skewed more towards the environment of FHS.



Also, based on low response numbers from some schools, the data collected may not be an accurate reflection of the climate of those schools.

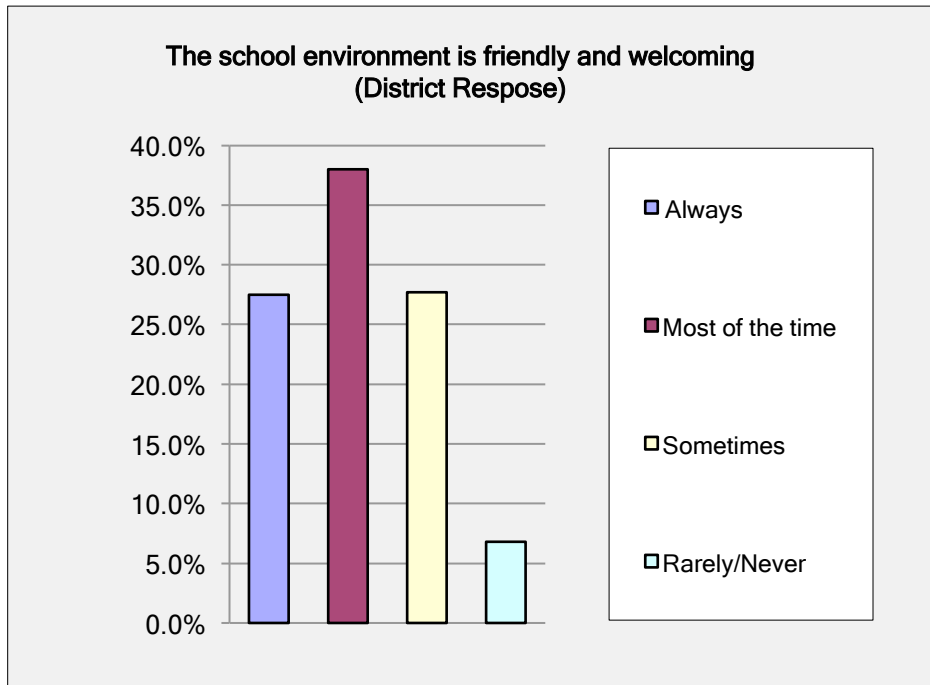

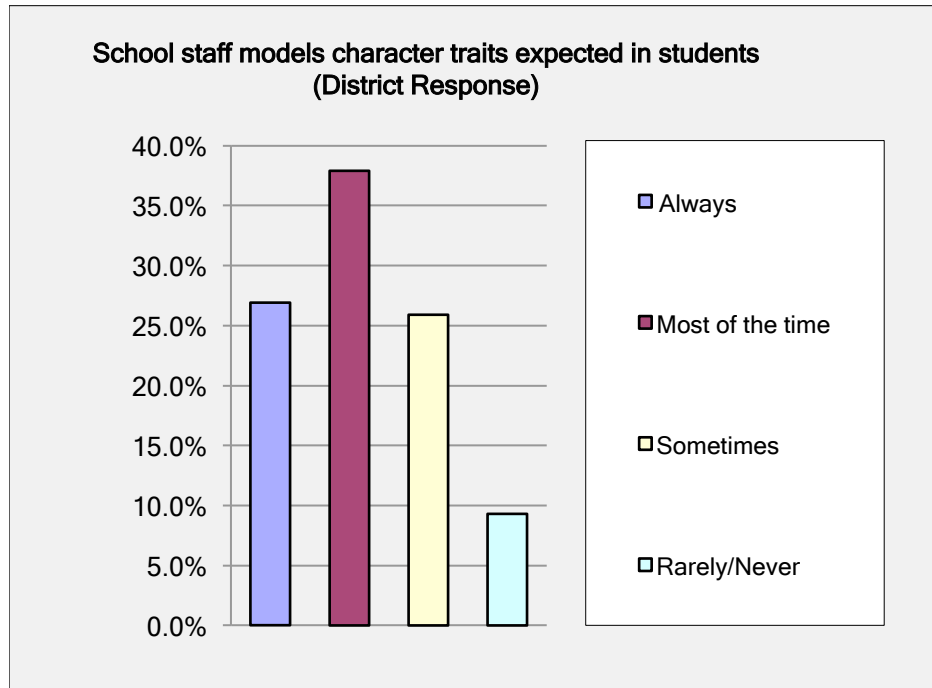

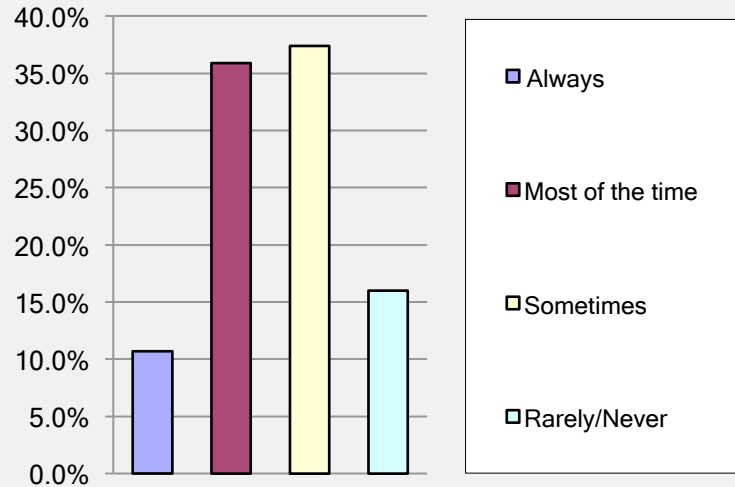

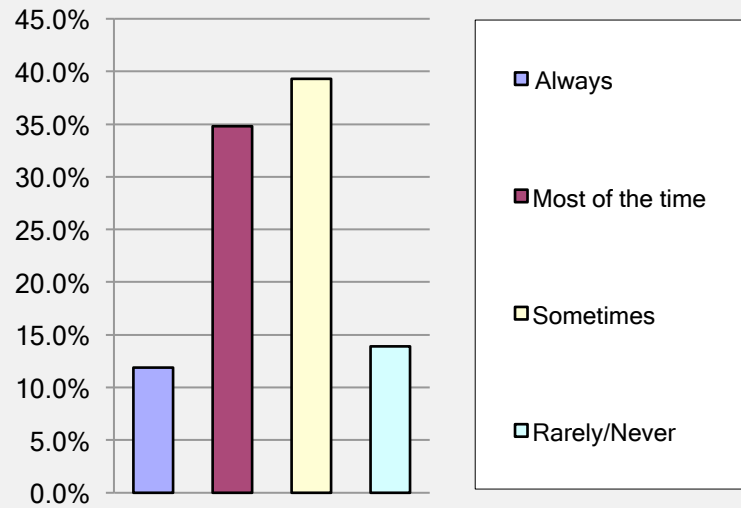

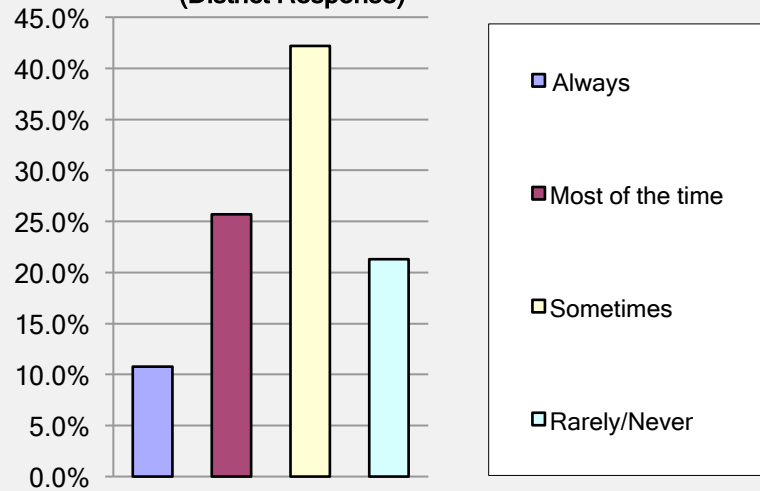

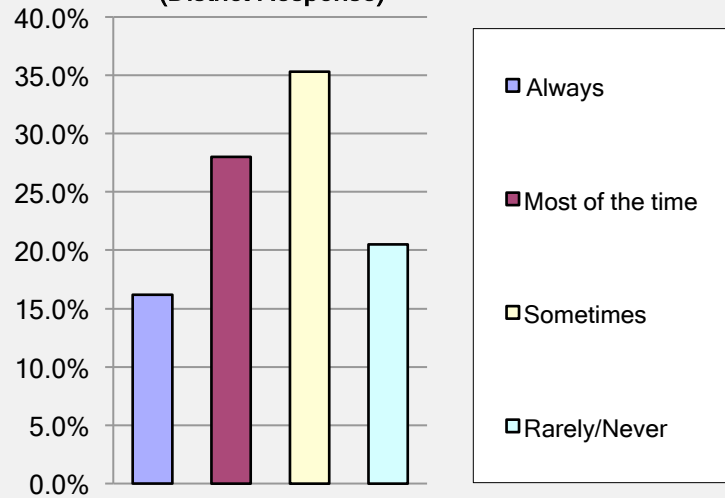
