

#### Fees:

This year we will be collecting a student fee and a technology fee. During our back-to-school bash, we will collect these fees. There will be an option to pay your fees online, but you will need to ensure you have access to your parent portal. If you need assistance with your parent portal, please reach out to our front office.

- **\$25 student fee** covers the first student ID and lanyard, grade level educational materials (science labs, etc...), guest speakers, and learning enrichment opportunities.
- \$30 Power Zone tech fee we have had the opportunity to bring more tech into our building and are excited about what this can provide for our students. That being said, with technology we need to ensure we have the correct systems in place to ensure an effective learning experience with technology. This tech fee will cover access to monitor your student's use and what they are doing on their Chromebooks to ensure a safe environment, provide access to learning sites for student intervention programs, and support our digital citizenship to teach all students how to use technology appropriately to enhance their learning.
- There will be an additional **(OPTIONAL) tech insurance for \$30.** This will cover the expense of a repair that is caused by **any misuse of the device.**
